Being the first to arrive and last to leave, the other stall owners have fondly given her the title of 'market manager'.

The stall her father left her means everything to her. Even though she does not earn much from selling vegetables, she is able to donate a large sum of money towards various charitable causes, including helping schools, orphanages and poor children.

Oscar-winning director, Lee Ang, said of Chen, "Money is only worthy if given to those in need." He added, "Of all she has given away, her greatest gift is to set a good example to others and inspire them."

Regular customers turn up at the stall with a vegetable basket and a camera, hoping for a picture with Chen. Despite all the attention, Chen remains humble. "I have done nothing extraordinary and everyone who wants to can do it. I do not place great importance on money. When I donate to help others, I feel happy and I can sleep well at night."

"My philosophy in life is simple: If doing something makes you worried, then it must be wrong. If it makes you happy, then you must have done the right thing. What others say is not important," says Chen.
