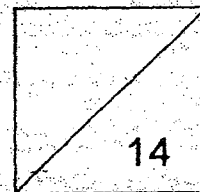

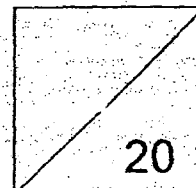

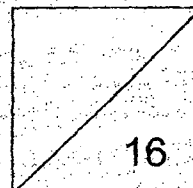

"I've to leave now," said the carpenter, "as I have many more bridges to build."

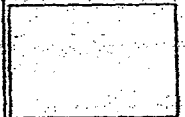
