
"Thank you for helping me. I have been stuck for hours. What's our wish?" the dwarf asked with a smile on his face.

Rocky was so busy chasing the mouse that he did not hear his owner, Mrs Cai, calling him for dinner.


"Well," said Mrs Cai. "This is very strange. Rocky always comes home for dinner. Something must have happened to Rocky."
