A Grass Head



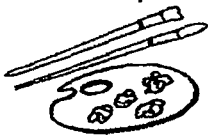
You will need:

cotton wool

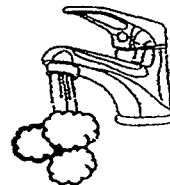
paper cup
