SECTION H: COMPREHENSION 2 (10 marks)

Read the following passage carefully and answer questions 40 to 44.

Orville and Wilbur Wright are credited with inventing the airplane. It all started when Orville was seven and Wilbur was eleven years old. The boys grew up loving to invent things. They got interested in flying when their father gave them a toy helicopter that flew with the help of rubber bands. They then experimented with making their own toy helicopters. Orville liked to build kites and he sold kites at school to make money. Wilbur started reading all he could about how birds flew and machines worked. The boys continued to be interested in machines and flight during their adult years.

By 1900, Orville and Wilbur built kites, known as gliders, that were large enough for a person to ride in. These gliders flew on air current and the pilot could get a ride of about 10 seconds before the glider came down to the ground. The brothers wanted to improve on the current glider and built a better glider that could be steered. It flew more than 182 metres but it still came down, no matter what the pilot did. To solve the problem, Orville and Wilbur finally decided to make an engine that would be light and powerful enough to power one of their gliders. With their mother's support and their own curiosity driving them, they made an engine that they thought would be more suitable and installed it on their newest glider.

17 December 1903 is a day to remember - Orville made the first successful powered flight in history! To soften the landings in case of a crash, a sandy place was needed. The place was Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. Kitty Hawk had lots of wind too, which was ideal for flying. The first flight lasted 12 seconds. This was not a simple or easy task they had completed. They had worked and experimented for years to perfect the wing design and controls. There was a lot of courage involved in making that first flight!
