# Section C: Comprehension (8 marks) Read the following passage and answer questions 15 to 19.

Fifty-six-year-old Chang Yang Fa still has his first toy; a Matchbox truck that was given to him when he was six. The father of three also has many playthings which he collected over the years. They are worth more than \$5 million.

Mr Chang's toy collection increased over a period of twenty-five years. He is now preparing to share his toys with the public by moving them to a toy museum, which is the first in Singapore. The toys which are now stored in various places will be housed in a \$2 million place in Seah Street.

"It's every toy collector's dream to open a museum where he can share his passion with other people," said Mr Chang. The toys can be traced back to toy makers from more than twenty-five countries. They were bought from auctions, junk stores and dealers by Mr Chang.

The toy collection includes a 1903 Steiff bear, a Batman figure that was shipped in a Superman packaging by mistake, and a 1930 plush Mickey that has creator Walt Disney's signature on its sole. Many pieces are still in mint condition.

"The museum can bring people back in time. It's meant to bring out the child in every one of us," said Mr Chang.

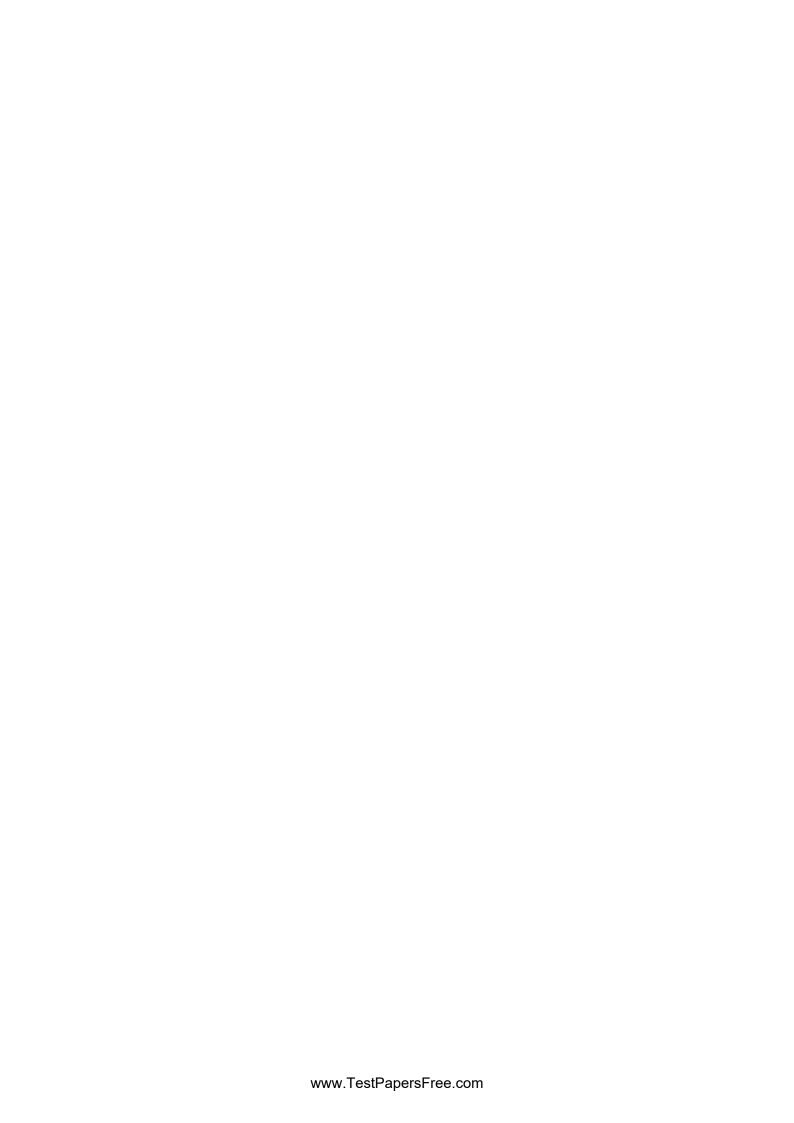
