seven new species of miniature frogs, smaller than bumblebees, have been
discovered clinging for (27) survival on isolated mountaintops in
Brazil.
The largest species of these new discoveries has a maximum
(28) of just thirteen millimetres at its adult stage. These new
species of frogs, which are among the smallest land vertebrates, have evolved over

achieve their miniature status.
Such evolution (31) means that the frogs emerge from
their eggs fully-formed looking like they would as (32) This

survive without being in pond water. Highly-efficient absorption allows
