



A little drama in the sea off the Esplanade on Sunday had made a hero out of a tourist from Malaysia.

Mr Lou told the reporters that he was taking a leisure walk with his friends after dinner when he spotted the woman perching on the railing and taking a selfie. He yelled out to her that it was dangerous to do that, but it was too late.

"When I looked into the water, I saw her struggling to keep afloat. I realised immediately that she could not swim," Mr Lou said. He was not aware that his feet were bleeding from the cuts he had picked up from stepping on the rough stones on the water edge while getting out of the water.

The woman was very fortunate to escape unharmed. However, she was embarrassed by her careless action.

Mr Lou was taken to the hospital where the nurses dressed his wounds. He was also given an injection to make sure that there would be no infection. The woman paid for his medical expenses and said that it was the least she could do for saving her life.
