In the animal kingdom, tails serve many different functions and purposes. For many animals, tails are used for balance. Dinosaurs, like the Tyrannosaurus-rex, used their tails to balance their heavy heads and bodies while walking on two legs. Kangaroos use their tails for balance while leaping, and their tails also function as a third leg that helps them to lift off into the air. Climbers like monkeys use their tails for balance and to grip vines and branches. 5

Some animals have evolved tails into weapons for defence. Stingrays have a spiked tail that they can use to defend against predators. When attacked, they whip around their spiked tails and release venom from them. Rattlesnakes have dried skin on their tail that make a rattling sound to scare off potential predators. 10

Lastly, animals that live in groups, like dogs and wolves, use the positions of their tails to indicate their rank and communicate with one another. Dogs wag their tails when excited, which is a form of communication with humans too.

Tails serve different functions for animals across different species. Tails have become an essential part of animals' survival as they have various uses, such as 15 balance, defence and communication.


