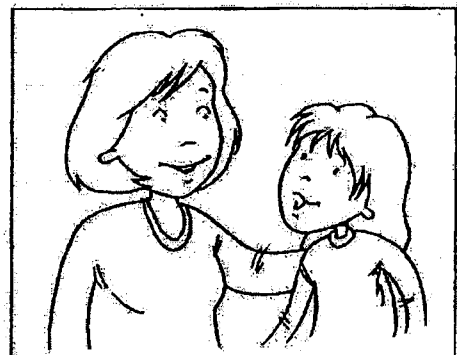

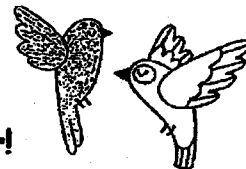

Figure skating is a very graceful sport. It is one in which individuals, pairs or groups perform on ice wearing figure skates. In competitions, skaters perform a short programme followed by a long one. There are many moves such as spins, jumps, lifts and death spirals. Major competitions generally conclude with an exhibition show in which the top skaters from each discipline perform non-competitive programmes. 5

One of the finest figure skaters in the world is Peggy Fleming. When she was about nine years old, her family had to move to Cleveland due to her father's work commitments. There, she learnt how to skate and grew to love the sport.

Peggy had a natural talent for skating. She was just a novice skater when she competed in the United States Figure Skating Championships in 1962, where she won the bronze medal. Undaunted, Peggy persisted in training hard and she emerged the champion for the next five years. Peggy's perseverance paid off when she received the gold medal at the Grenada Olympics. 10

After retiring, Peggy contributed to the sport in many ways. She appeared in many television programmes and interviews to promote the sport. Her breathtaking performances earned her worldwide fame. In fact, she was one of the first skaters ever invited to perform at the White House. Fleming is widely admired for her skill and elegance in the sports. She will always be a model for future skaters to emulate. 15 20
